# Who We Are

Cyber-Seniors is a non-profit organization whose mission is to bridge the digital divide and connect generations through technology.

Since our inception in 2015, we have developed and disseminated thousands of resources that enable organizations such as libraries, senior centres, retirement homes, schools, and places of worship in the United States and Canada to provide tech-training for senior citizens using an intergenerational, youth volunteer model.

In light of COVID-19 restrictions, Cyber-Seniors has become a digital-first organization, rerouting our existing services to a virtual format.

# **Our Mission**

Cyber-Seniors grew out of the need for older adults to remain socially connected and self-sufficient, and in the wake of COVID-19, our work has never been more important.

During this time of imposed self-isolation, it is crucial for seniors to stay connected to their families, friends and communities. Whether by keeping up with news, using a website to order food or visiting with friends and family via video conferencing, tech fluency makes an enormous difference in allowing seniors to remain self-sufficient and socially connected from the safety of their own homes. In the best of times, digital literacy can be life altering; in times like these, it can be life saving.

Cyber-Seniors responded immediately to the COVID-19 crisis by ensuring seniors had access to technology training and support by setting up a call center and offering daily webinars and one-on-one tech support in several languages. We invested in state-of-the-art technology to ensure security, confidentiality and quality assurance. In 2020, we served over 8,500 seniors who partook in over 26,000 tech-training sessions - all free of charge, and our reach is growing by approximately 3% per week.

As the seniors who participate in our program become more comfortable using technology in their daily lives, they find a welcoming intergeneration community with Cyber-Seniors. We have recently identified a need to expand our programming beyond tech-training to provide seniors with additional opportunities to remain socially connected, self-sufficient and engaged members of their community. Areas of development include programming to include virtual activities, such as exercise classes and social programs, as well as learning to access essential government services and programs online.

We are also developing programs that will allow seniors to mentor and provide workshops and presentations for young people who volunteer for Cyber-Seniors.









# Meet the Cyber-Seniors

Cyber-Seniors are as young as their late 50s and life-experienced as their early 90s; we even count a handful of centenarians among our digital enthusiasts. Our growing community is interested learning about cyber-security, the best ways to edit and post photos, and, most importantly, how to keep in touch with loved ones during the pandemic.

# **Our Reach**

Cyber-Seniors delivers up to 15 webinars and over 70 one-on-one tech-support sessions with senior citizens each week - all free of charge. Approximately 400 unique seniors and 100 young people participate weekly in our programs, and over 1900 individuals tune-in to watch previously recorded webinars weekly. In 2020, we engaged over 8,500 seniors who partook in over 26,000 tech training sessions and over 1,500 young people who provided in excess of 5,000 volunteer hours. Our growth rate of senior and youth participants is approximately 3% per week.
